#### Amateur-Owner-Handler Class (effective as of 1/1/2009)

Chapter 3, Section 7 - The Amateur-Owner-Handler Class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13).

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES - EACH SHOW

**NR2.09100. Stud Dog Class** - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Get **MUST** be entered in one of the Regular Classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires only one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed.


**NR2.09200. Brood Bitch Class** - Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.


As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog & Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

**NR2.09300. Brace** - Two dogs of the same breed and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers - Dogs and Bitches may be entered in the same Brace. **Brace will require a fee of \$17.00 as a Unit, provided the dogs are entered in another class.** If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only" and pay a **separate entry fee of \$28.00 for each dog** so entered. Dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time of entry. Specify "Brace Class" on the entry form. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be designated, "Brace #1," "Brace #2," etc.
